First Lady Brut Rosé

Varietal:

100% Pinot Noir

Wine Of Origin:

Western Cape

In The Glass:

A pastel pink colour with notes of peach and strawberries bursting out of the glass with red apple and sherbet on the palate. Its fine mouse and a crisp finish make this an ideal accompaniment on any summers day.

Winemaking:

This sparkling wine is produced in the classical method, or as we call it in South Africa, Cap Classique. Grapes are hand-picked and whole bunch pressed to gently extract the juice. After the base wine completed its primary fermentation in stainless steel, the blend was made and prepared for its secondary fermentation in the bottle. A specific amount of sugar and yeast was added, and the bottle was capped with a crown cap. This mixture necessary for secondary fermentation creates bubbles in the wine. After 24 months on the lees, the bottle is riddled and disgorged. The crown cap is removed, and the bottle is corked, dressed, labeled, and ready to drink.
